### How health insurance works



Your medical provider orders a test.

Your insurance sends you an Explanation of Benefits (EOB). This is not a bill!



We send you a bill for the amount you are responsible for paying.

### What if my insurance doesn't cover the test?

Most insurance companies cover this testing, whether Natera is in or out of network.<sup>2</sup> If your insurance doesn't cover the test, you may be eligible for a prompt-pay cash option.

### What if I have a high deductible health plan?

High-deductible health plans have a higher set dollar amount you must pay before your plan begins to cover your care. However, because you're receiving reproductive care you'll likely meet your deductible, and what you pay for your test will go toward that cost.

### What if I don't have insurance or can't afford the cost?
